The overdistributed net investment income balance includes realized gain (loss) on the sale of contingent debt and Section 305 sales adjustments for accrual of deemed dividends from investments in convertible debt in accordance with federal income tax treatment.

Net Investment Income for the fiscal quarter and six months ended August 31, 2019 includes market premium amortization on corporate bonds of \$241,691 (less than \$0.01 per common share) and \$473,397 (\$0.01 per common share), respectively. For tax purposes, the Fund has elected not to amortize market premium on corporate bonds.
